Hearts Getaway- Overnight weekends with movies, games, arts & crafts, Campfire stories and bond while socializing with others. Lots of different outside games such as basketball, kickball flag football, bean bag toss and more. Campers can arrive Friday at 5pm then pick up Sunday by 4pm

Camp- Spring break Camp one week in march. Summer camp May to August - 10 week period where our students are taught critical thinking and cognitive skills. Students participate in activities such as music therapy, recreational sports, and socialization training. where individuals will attend weekly activities such as Art Adventure, Music's fest, Scavenger Hunt, and Summer Blast

After School Program- We host sessions from 3-6 pm, Monday to Friday, where we create a calming environment for students with disabilities to improve their communication skills using special training and specialized devices.

Vocational Rehabilitation-Helping individuals get back to work and Educate the community.

Providing on the job training. Assisting with interviews. Assisting with finding employment. Providing interview training. Assistance with attire for an interview. Assist with filling out Application, Assist with preparing resume. Summer camp workshops visiting college and different companies.

Nonprofits Roundtable Committee (NRC)
