We serve children ages 8-21 and adults 22 and up, from all socioeconomic backgrounds, races and religions, with programs that challenge, educate, and inspire. We bring together typically developing individuals, individuals with neurodevelopmental differences, individuals from underserved areas. We believe that by including as many children and young adults as possible, we create a stronger community that can learn and work together. Michael Hearts Academy will provide several services.

Parental Support Workshops- Parents are offered assistance with resources to enhance the lives of their disabled children; these include Specialized equipment, Training, and Consultations with professionals on physical therapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, Guardianship and behavioral therapy. It's a great opportunity for parents to connect with other parents, share tips, and grow a community of support.

After School Program- We host sessions from 3-6 pm, Monday to Friday, where we create a calming environment for students with disabilities to improve their communication skills using special training and specialized devices. Hearts Getaway- Overnight weekends with movies, games, arts & crafts, Campfire stories and bond while socializing with others. Lots of different outside games such as basketball kickball flag football bean bag toss and more. Campers can arrive Friday at 5pm then pick up Sunday by 4pm

Day/Summer Camp-May to August - 10 week period where our students are taught critical thinking and cognitive skills. Students participate in activities such as music therapy, recreational sports, and socialization training. Day Camp runs year-round 730am-230p where individuals will attend weekly activities such as Art Adventure, Music's fest, Scavenger Hunt, and Summer Blast

Vocational Rehabilitation-Helping individuals get back to work and Educate the community. Providing on the job training. Assisting with interviews. Assisting with finding employment. Providing interview training. Assistance with attire for interview. Assist with filling out Application, Assist with preparing resume.
